## Our mission

We build schools and neighborhoods for Ukrainian communities destroyed by the war. We are not just rebuilding Ukraine to its pre-war state — our innovative urban planning strategy helps reinvigorate and transform Ukrainian towns into sustainable, eco-friendly and modern urban spaces.





## Russian aggression destroyed Ukrainian societies, infrastructure and culture

The city of Mykolaiv (Southern Ukraine) has been under constant shelling since the beginning of Russia's full-scale invasion. The front line is situated 50 kilometers away, with the closest area being the Shipyard district of Mykolaiv.

## Current goal



Our flagship project is rebuilding the biggest school in Mykolaiv, in southern Ukraine destroyed by the war.

In direct collaboration with the city's administration and Mykolaiv's chief architect, we're not just rebuilding it—we're transforming it into a modern energy-saving facility focused on teaching the kids the basics of agriculture, ecology and sustainable living.





# Challenge

## Problems:

School 48 is destroyed by shelling and cannot provide middle-high school education to hundreds of kids in one of the biggest residential districts

Elementary schools are struggling with capacity too



## Solution:

combine elementary and higher school facilities into a modern education complex for 1,326 kids

## Outcomes:

restoring crucial educational capabilities for the kids

one solution for two critical infrastructural problems of the city

creating a new progressive educational environment for both kids and the staff

establishing a new direction for civil infrastructure development for the entire Ukraine



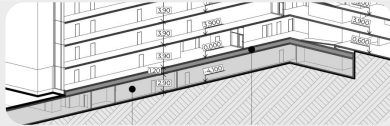
# What we'll do

**Nurture the grower generation**



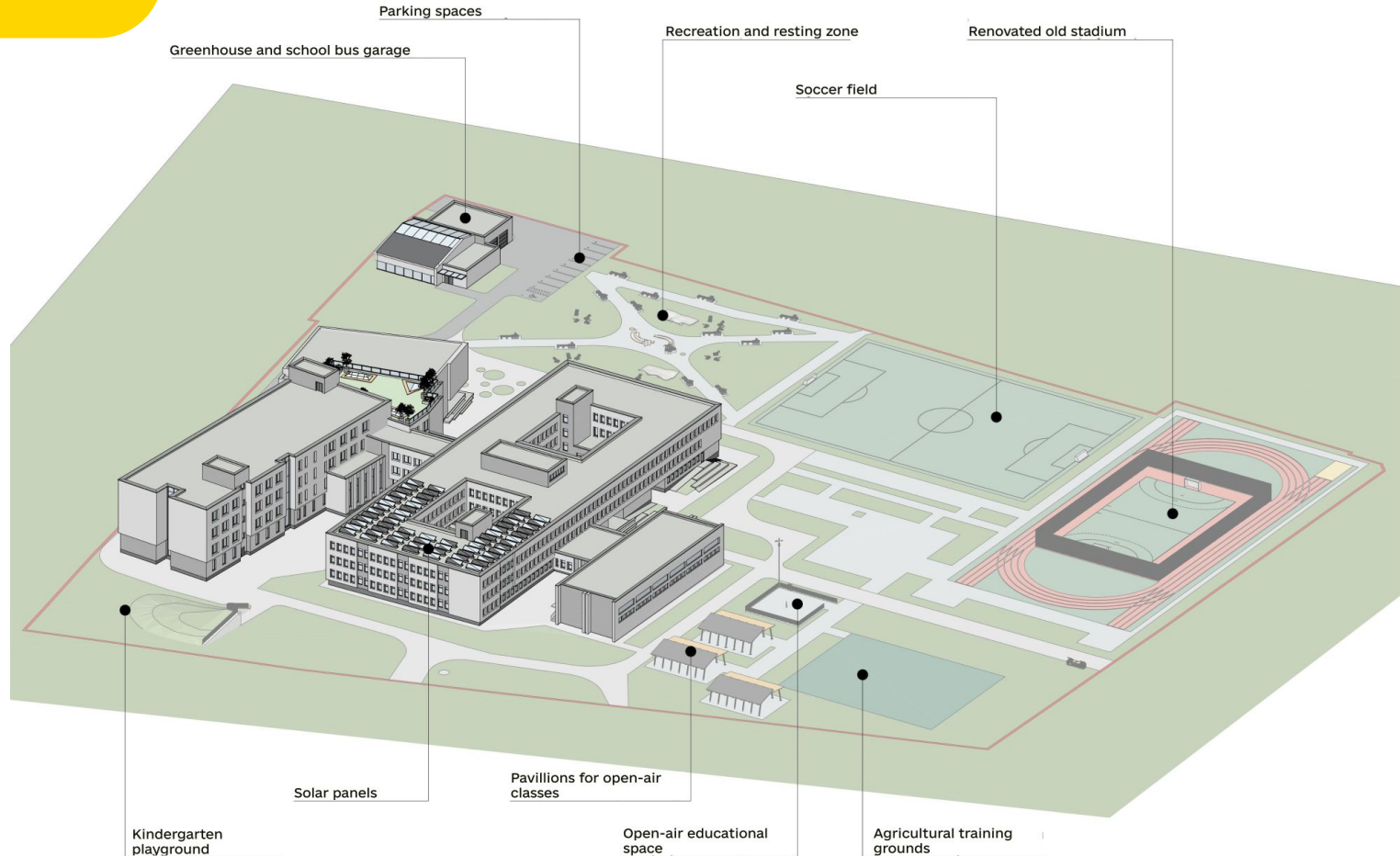
→ Unique focus on agriculture to prepare the kids for future careers in the agricultural industry, biology and more

**4** The creation of new jobs will support the economy and sustainable development.

**5** Cultural and sports zones will attract the community and stimulate business.

**6** Improvements in navigation and logistics will increase the accessibility and cost-effectiveness of investments.

We work in close partnership with international organizations, NGOs, and the Ukrainian government, leveraging the expertise and resources of each partner to achieve the maximum impact.

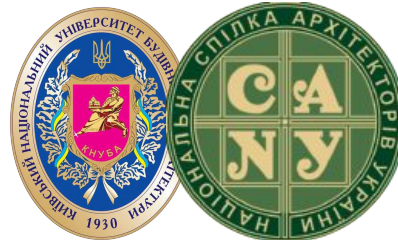

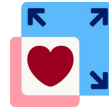
